

## ***Thank you for your interest in THRIVE Girls Campus!***

THRIVE Girls Christian Campus is a residential discipleship and academic program for adolescent girls ages 12-17. Students work on their school academics and Teen Challenge individual and group curriculum 1<sup>st</sup> period, 2<sup>nd</sup> period and 3<sup>rd</sup> period. After 3<sup>rd</sup> period students attend PE and recreation. Our academic curriculum Sevenstar program exceeds the national education standards and our Teen Challenge discipleship programs continue to exceed above average since 1958. Students attend prayer and devotion once in the morning after breakfast and once in the evening after dinner.

We are here for families and their teens who are struggling with problems that are with addiction, emotional, social, behavioral, or of a spiritual nature. Individual therapy, family therapy and pet therapy (chickens, goats, equine therapy) is available.

There is admissions information listed on our website that will help in your decision-making process. Tuition fees and costs are located on the last page of the application. (The application admissions fee will be waived.) Financial options are located under the Admissions Tab on our webpage at the bottom of the page. The first step, we need to take in getting help for your daughter, is the application and medical form completed, signed and returned via email to: [thrivegirlsacademy@tctexas.org](mailto:thrivegirlsacademy@tctexas.org)

Once we have reviewed the 1st application paperwork, we can determine if our program is the right fit for your daughter and your family. When approved by the Administrative Team you will receive a letter of acceptance within 24 hours for Admissions. Then a 2nd set of paperwork is sent that requires notarization. Generally, it takes 7-10 days to complete all paperwork. We would then contact you to schedule an Admission date for Intake that both works best for your family and for our campus schedule. On the agreed date you would bring your daughter and complete the admissions.
